SITUATION

On September 28th, 7.4 magnitude earthquake struck Sulawesi, Indonesia, triggering a tsunami that hit the city of Palu with crests reaching 18 feet high. The events caused widespread destruction to homes and infrastructure. About 1,200 people have been reported dead with numbers expected to rise as many are still missing and rescue teams continue their search.
