SITUATION

While the South Asia monsoon plays a critical role in the success of India's crops, the rain can also cause devastating floods. Since mid-June, monsoon rains have been impacting much of India; in Assam, an eastern state of India, 1.3 million people have been affected by the subsequent flooding. More than 27,000 people are currently living in 270 relief camps and 24 people have died as a result of the floods.
