

SITUATION

On December 25, 2020, a bomb in an RV exploded in the streets of downtown Nashville, Tennessee. Approximately 400 people lost their homes and an additional 1,200 people lost their jobs as at least 40 businesses in the area were damaged. Included in the damages was a communications service facility, which affected networks throughout the region.





RESPONSE

Lutheran Disaster Response is supporting the Southeastern Synod of the ELCA in the aftermath of the bombing in Nashville. The Southeastern Synod is providing disaster chaplains to deliver spiritual and emotional care to those impacted by the bombing. They will also work with partners such as the Salvation Army, Connexion, and Catholic Charities to address immediate needs.
