SITUATION

Hurricane Michael, with sustained winds of nearly 155 mph, made landfall on the Florida coast early yesterday afternoon as a Category 4 storm, the strongest to hit the Florida Panhandle since record-keeping began.

Widespread devastation is being reported and so far, two deaths have been confirmed and more than 900,000 homes and business have lost power across multiple states.
