LWF - Jerusalem **Augusta Victoria Hospital**

The Augusta Victoria Hospital (AVH) is a center of medical excellence in East Jerusalem, serving the five million Palestinians in the West Bank and Gaza. It is operated by the Lutheran World Federation since 1950.

As one of the six hospitals in the East Jerusalem Hospitals Network, AVH is the only hospital that offers radiotherapy for cancer patients in the West Bank and Gaza, with 171 in-patientbeds. AVH treats about 700 patients daily.

AVH is fully licensed by the Israeli Ministry of Health, receives referrals from the Palestinian Authority (PA) for cancer and kidney care, and is closely connected with Palestinian identity and institution building. AVH operates under the highest quality standards and is certified by the international accreditation body, the Joint Commission International (IJC) as well as ISO.



About the Referral System Agreement

2002

LWF designated as referral institution for the Palestinian Authority, given the shortage of oncology and nephrology treatments in the West Bank and Gaza

2016

Referral agreement between the Palestinian Authority and LWF updated in May 2016. Prices for all services were agreed. Comparisons have shown that these prices remain the lowest compared to private hospitals in the West Bank and Israel.



UPDATE AS PER 31 AUGUST 2020 **Agreement between the Palestinian Authority and AVH** about monthly billings and the gradual reduction of the debts until October 2020:



The PA will increase monthly transfers to the hospital from 5 to 8 million NIS as an advance payment on a monthly basis.



The PA will reduce its accumulated debt in the form of equal monthly installments of 10 million NIS divided over 12-18 payments.



The PA will pay 20 million NIS immediately pending verification that the government can financially afford it.



The PA MoF will release 'emergency stabilization' payments on an "as needed" basis to ensure that the total amount owed is below the threshold of 100 million NIS.
